Select three postcards from the article. For each postcard, answer the following:

Postcard	#1	#2	#3
Describe what you see. Identify manmade objects, natural features, people, human activity or actions taking place.			
Check for a caption. If there is one, what does it tell you about the scene or the town.			
Estimate a time frame. When do you think the postcard was created? What visual clues (clothing, buildings, vehicles, technology, colors, etc.) support your guess?			
Interpret the message. What story or impression do you think the postcard is trying to communicate about the town. List two details (words or images) that support your interpretation.
